

Transport for growth in North West Auckland

Report by Kevin Casbott

A combined group from Auckland Transport, Auckland Council and the NZ Transport Agency hosted a public consultation in the Whenuapai Hall on Saturday 12 March.

The aim of the consultation was to present some ideas on what the thinking is for future transport requirements to cope with the growth in north-west Auckland.

It was also an opportunity to raise ideas and concerns from the local community. Needless to say topics like upgrades to Brigham Creek Road and a footpath along Kauri Road were commented on. Some of the ideas presented were:

Whenuapai public transport options Planning is underway for the northwestern busway from the CBD to

Westgate. Should we also:

- Extend the busway or bus priority to Kumeu?
- Extend the busway or bus priority to Constellation Bus Station?
- Future proof these for light rail?

Should feeder bus services be provided between Whenuapai and ferries at Hobsonville and West Harbour?

Improved SH16 to SH18 connection


Should a more direct connection from SH16 to SH18 be provided to relieve pressure on Brigham Creek Road?

Or should Brigham Creek Road have a major upgrade?

- · Totara Road to Trig Road.


This consultation was not about informing the community about what has been decided; rather to signal what is being considered and to ask for feedback.

Dig that Clay!

Clay soils are usually cold and wet in the winter and spring, but they can be dried out by covering with large sheets of plastic or you can plant under cloches. It is not advisable to dig clay soils in the winter. A clay based garden can be controlled and developed into a fertile garden by regularly adding gypsum, sand, peat, lime or dolomite to the clay. It will quickly produce a good productive soil. The best time to plant is in late winter or early spring, while the soil is moist. Clay soils are well suited to growing roses, and some bulbs.

During April, keep those fallen leaves cleared away as they are a source of infection in the coming season. Earwigs, red spider mite and white fly can damage crops and should be sprayed. Watch out for caterpillars, and white fly who favour hibiscus, poinsettia, gerberas and herbs such as sage and mint, also vegetable seedlings such as squash, melon, egg plant, cabbage, beans, tomato and broccoli.

Natural Spray -

All Purpose pest spray for any leaf eating pests:

1 Garlic bulb

1 Onion (small)

1 teaspoon Powdered Cayenne Pepper

1ltr Water

1 Tbsp Liquid Dish Soap

Chop, grind or liquefy garlic and onion. Add cayenne pepper and mix with water. Steep 1 hour, strain then add liquid dish soap and mix well. Spray plants including underside of leaf. Store mixture up to 1 week, covered and labelled in fridge.

Herbs~

How wonderful to see so many people using herbs for cooking and first aid in the home. Rosemary can be burnt in a sick room to reduce fevers, is good for high blood pressure as well as a heart and liver tonic. Rosemary tea helps relieve headaches and is a good mouth wash. It is good for mental stimulation and helping the memory along with pine, thyme and sage.

Parsley is best eaten raw every day. It is rich in vitamins and minerals and a good source of iron. Add it to raw juices and it sweetens the breath. Garnish vegetable and meat dishes, mix finely chopped into hot mashed potatoes, add to stews soups salads or sandwiches.

ANZAC biscuits always a favourite

Ingredients:

1 cup Flour

1 cup Sugar

1 cup Coconut (desiccated)

2 cups Rolled Oats

125g Butter

2Tbsp Golden Syrup

3Tbsp Boiling Water

1tsp Baking Soda

Method:

Preheat over to 180degC. Line two baking trays with nonstick baking paper. Place flour, sugar, coconut and oats in a bowl and stir to combine. Make a well in the centre. Place butter and golden syrup in a saucepan to melt, or microwave to melt. Dissolve baking soda in boiling water. Add melted ingredients and dissolved baking soda to dry ingredients and mix to combine.

Roll spoonfuls into balls and press onto prepared baking trays, allowing space for biscuits to spread while cooking. Back for 12-15 minutes or until firm and golden brown. Remove to a wire rack to cool, and enjoy!

Makes approximately 30 biscuits.



Real Estate – The new headline generator

Hundreds of consents lodged! New houses not selling! Buyers lining up with IRD numbers! New houses pre-sold! Lowest listing numbers in years! Lead times for new dwellings over 12months!

Real Estate became the new "quiet news day" story. The situation in Auckland is all over the place, varies by area and unpredictable as ever. Commentary from one real estate brand can be negative on one day and optimistic the next adding to the confusion.

Think it might be worth having a real estate commentary based on what happened, what is set in stone and based on facts! I think readers want to know 3 things: What's my house worth? What's happening around me and will it affect my price? Does a landbanker want my property... for lots of money?

Special housing areas aside (as these are mostly approved now) there is a land-grab of sorts in areas of Northwest. 





Herb Group's making a home in Whenuapai

The group held its second meeting in the Whenuapai Hall, on Tuesday the 5th April at 7.15pm. The group meets on the first Tuesday of each month.

Lemon Balm was the 'herb of the month' in April. Diane handed out an informative brochure on Lemon Balm along with recipes. After supper, guest speaker Minette, from 'Meadow Sweet Herbs' spoke to the group on 'Chilli Peppers'. The multitudes of shapes and sizes, the range of exciting colours, and of course their delicious pungent heat has made the chilli popular all over the world. Here's what we learnt...

- The Gulf of Mexico was the birth place of the chilli.
- Christopher Columbus found the chilli on his travels.
- Capsicums, chillisand peppers are all in the same family.
- There are over 70 varieties.
- The five most common, domesticated species are as follows: Capsicum Annuum, Capsicum Baccatum, Capsicum Chinense, Capsicum Frutescens and Capsicum Pubescens.
- In 1912 Wilbur Scoville created, heat measurement units to chart the hotness of a pepper (from mild to extremely hot). This is called 'Seoville Heat Units (SHU) and is still in use
- 'Carolina Reaper' is the worlds' hottest chilli, and it appears in the Guinness World records.
- Chilli are easy to grow, all they need is warm weather, water and good soil. Feed the plant when it starts fruiting. Epsom salts, seaweed, and tomato food all work well.
- Preserving: Dry, freeze, smoke, pickle, process or freeze. Any form of preserving works well.
- Culinary: Chilli don't lose their flavour while cooking and can be used in numerous dishes, from salads, casseroles, Asian cooking, stuffed, chilli chocolate, ice-cream, brownies and more!
- Beat the burn! Try taking a little milk, yogurt, sugar, rice or bread if you have burning in your mouth. Do not drink water, it won't help the burn.
- Medical: Cayanne Pepper is extremely versatile and has many medical benefits. Be very careful as hot peppers and chilli can burn if you touch your face after handling them. Tip: rub a little cooking oil on your hands before you chop up chilli for cooking. After handling wash your hands thoroughly, this will prevent chilli juices lingering.
