## Herald Island Community Wharf Trust

The Herald island Community Trust was formed 14th October 1999 and has as its main objectives 'to hold, maintain, administer and make available for the educational and recreational use of the people of Auckland the property known as 'The Old Wharf' located at Twin Wharf Road, Herald Island.... the recreational use of the facility for fishing, boating and general enjoyment of the upper harbour area.... the education training and development of children and adults in the marine and tidal conditions that occur in the area...the general beautification and the foreshore of the community wharf and immediate area'.

There are four trustees: Two representing the interests of the Herald island Boating Club and two appointed to represent the interests of Herald Island and the people of Auckland. There is no requirement that any Trustee must be a current resident of Herald Island or current member of any organisation. Current trustees are: Frank Reynolds (Boating Club); Eugene Johnson (Boating Club); Craig Carr Herald Island and People of Auckland; Noel Rugg Herald Island and People of Auckland (current Treasurer and secretary). There is no Chairman; any decisions are required to be by simple majority.

The primary function of the Trust is to establish the necessary funds to be held in a reserve account to cover the costs of insurance, public liability and the major maintenance

There is an undertaking with RNZAF, Police, Auckland Harbour Patrols and Emergency organisations to ensure the wharf is available to them as a priority in the event any emergency occurs, or for training purposes.

Today, small surveys indicate over 80% of the Community Wharf users are residents from with the wider West Auckland area. The wharf is one of the few floating pontoon type structures on the Auckland Harbour where the public has open access to and children can be taught and enjoy the fun of sprat fishing and sometimes seeing even larger fish landed. Getting fishermen to keep the wharf in a tidy and safe condition is a major challenge and Trustees spend many hours of voluntary work policing the use of the wharf and its maintenance.

# Community wharf undergoes a 20 year refit



Thanks to years of quiet planning by the Community Wharf Trust, a twenty thousand dollar bill for the recent overhaul of the wharf has been undertaken from the special financial reserves of the trust, without any financial hardship on the wider community.

Within the last two weeks piles have been reconditioned, there has been replacement of long pontoon clamp bolts, new pile guide sleeves and servicing the gangplank access way, has all been achieved, in time for the peak summer.

The Trusts financial reserves are now empty, so it will start work over the coming years to rebuild its funds for the next round of maintenance. The Council previously provided funding.

Today, we have one of the top floating pontoon wharves in Auckland so hundreds of Aucklanders of all ages can continue spending a few hours of fun and excitement fishing.

Craig Carr, a long time Herald Island resident and one of the Wharf Trustees is an experienced marine technician. He oversaw the massive maintenance job and managed the safety and handover aspects.

The community wharf was originally established to make facilities available for the educational and recreational use of the people of Auckland. With the growth of the wider northwest Auckland population, the community wharf has become increasingly popular. It remains one of only a few public wharves on the Auckland harbour using a floating pontoon.

The community wharf also provides access facilities to the Police, Harbourmaster and RNZAF in the event of any emergencies.



It is difficult to keep on top of the garden with this changeable weather. As soon as the soil gets some rainwater the wind comes and dries it out. Various herbs are coming into their own, as they like it dryer. My Ginger mint is pushing its way through again after the winter. This is a lovely variegated mint with lots of flowers that the bees love. Plant it in pots if you don't want it to spread, and use in salads.

Alstromerias are in full bloom now and there are some lovely colour variations. They are ideal for picking and last reasonably well in a vase. Change the water regularly and remove lower leaves so no greenery is in the water to make it slimy. Lavender is also in bloom along with some lovely Salvias. 

#### Chocolate Bliss Balls

1 cup Fruit (sultanas, prunes, apricots etc)

½ cup Walnuts and/or Almonds

1 Orange

1TBsp Orange juice, Grand Mariner or Brandy

Process all ingredients until well chopped. Add 2-3 large pieces of chocolate cake, 1TBsp of orange juice or Grand Mariner or Brandy. Mix well. Roll spoonfuls in to balls. Roll the balls in coconut and refrigerate.

## Preparing for an interview - Part 1 of 3

You have done your CV, now its preparation time for when you get an interview. Getting a job interview is a great achievement. It shows that the employer was impressed and wants to find our more about you. At the interview the employer is trying to choose the right person for the job and your trying to prove that you are the right person.

You'll need to plan what you want to ask and practice what you want to say. Being prepared shows that you have initiative and are motivated - two qualities that employers look for.

#### What the employer might ask:

Every interviewer is different, but there are some types of questions that are nearly always asked.

- Tell me about yourself
- Tell me about your last job
- What are your skills/strengths? What equipment can you use? Have you done this type of work
- Tell me about your education and training?
- What involvement do you have with clubs / sports / the community?
- Do you see yourself doing any further training?
- What is your greatest achievement?
- Can you describe a time you didn't succeed at something?
  - Give an example of a problem you've fixed.
- What are your weaknesses?
- What motivates you to do a good job? What will you get from the job?
- Do you prefer to work alone or in a group?
- What are your ambitions / plans for the future?
- What were you paid in your last job?
- What wage do you expect?
- What do you know about us?
- What interests you about the job? Why do you want to work for us?

If you have been out of work a while, have gaps in your CV or have had a lot of employers, you may be asked about it and should have a brief explanation ready.

If an employer asks you if you've ever been fired or convicted of a crime tell the truth. Say briefly what happened, explain how you've changed or what you'd do differently now and ask for a second chance.

## Home security during the holiday period

Summer is the time many of us head off on holiday. But while we might like to make lists of all the things we need to take with us, there's another checklist we need to tick off – one to make your property secure.

Let's face it, nothing advertises an owner's absence more than pulled blinds, an overflowing letterbox and a house shrouded in darkness at night. These are all things you can avoid with a little forethought.

The checklist that follows includes advice from NZ Police that will ensure you are doing your best to secure your property over the holiday period, and it's all about making sure your home looks lived in.

- 1. Alert the neighbours Tell your neighbours when you will be away.
- 2. Clear that letterbox Cancel newspaper subscriptions. You can ask the neighbours to clear your letterbox, or contact NZ Post to have your mail held while you are away. Consider adding a sticker to the letterbox to prevent unsolicited mail.
- 3. Shine a light Smart home technology makes it easy to have lights switching on and off while you're on holiday. Some systems will also open and close blinds, and control garden irrigation systems.
  - Don't leave your house in the dark at night. Put a lamp on a timer so it looks as though someone is home.
- 4. READ MORE! Don't post-holiday snaps on social media.
- **5. Blinds up** It is recommended that you leave the curtains open and the blinds pulled up.
- **6.** Ring ring Turn down the ringer on your phone. If no one is answering a phone it's a sure sign there's nobody at home.
- 7. Locked and closed It goes without saying that all windows, should be closed, and doors locked. Make sure garages and garden sheds are also locked. Ladders and tools that could be used to break into the house need to be stored away. Leave a spare key with a neighbour, not hidden under a stone where it can be found easily.
- **8.** No posts Police suggest you don't post pictures of your holiday on social media until after you are home.



- **9. Garden watch** If your garden that needs regular watering, arrange to have someone give the garden a good soak every second day. Pot plants, also, will need to be watered.
- 10. Be proactive If you don't already have a house alarm, consider getting one. It will probably reduce your home contents insurance premium, and will help to deter burglars.
- \* NZ Police also recommends you identify and mark your valuables, and take photographs of portable items that are more likely to be picked up by an intruder.
- \* Sensor-activated outdoor security lights are good deterrents.
- \* Wireless CCTV cameras are another way to deter criminals. Happy holidays!
